The family picnic would be at the park.

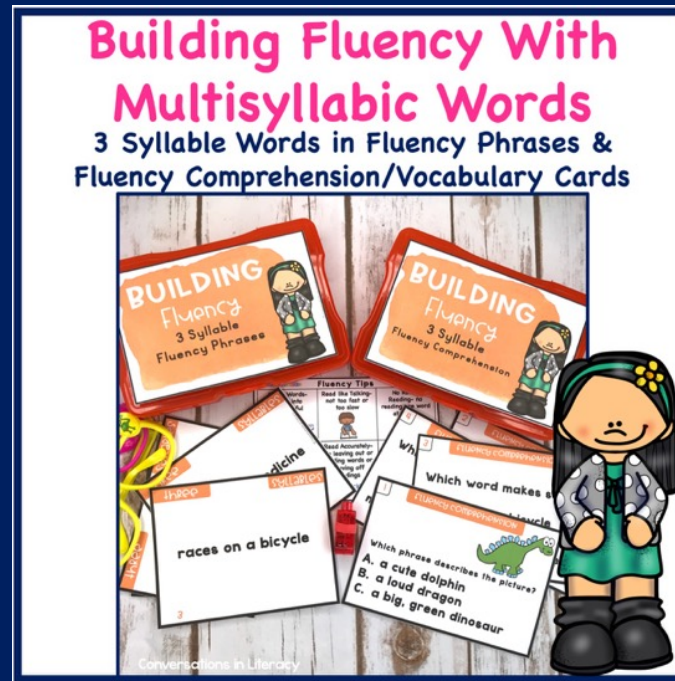
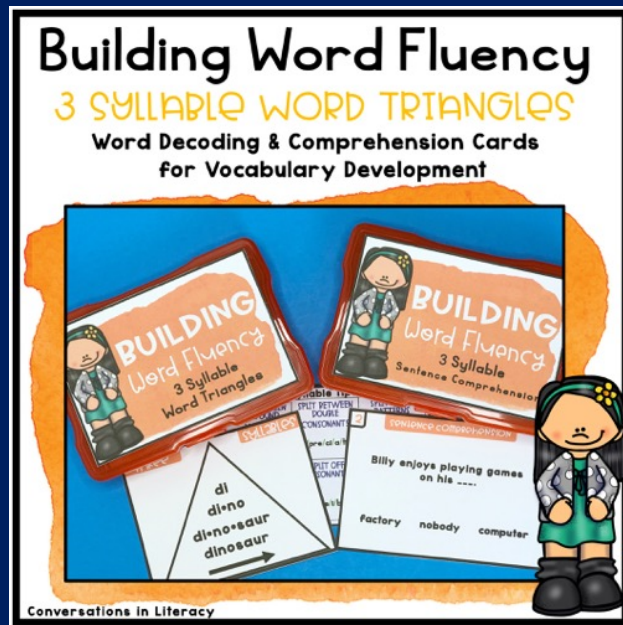
2. Name two items the family would eat at the picnic.

Mom decides to bring lemonade because she thought it would be refreshing on a hot day.

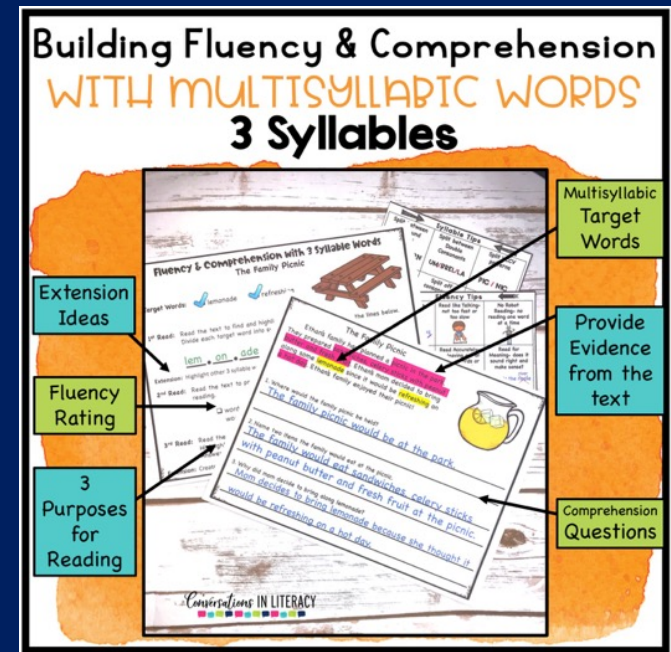
